Who is kinesthetic?

- Kinesthetic: moves a lot, likes touching, looks for a contact, has a plenty of imagination, reacts strongly emotionally.
- - they like to move and through working they learn
- - they definitely speak better than write
- - they speak a lot, very easily, smoothly and melodiously
- - they often have a nice voice also known as „the voice of a radio host”
- - they are extremely sensitive to the sounds, they’ve got a good hearing and they are familiar with music
- - they have so-called „musical memory”; from movies they remember dialogues and music the most
- - they have a problem with geometry, maps and diagrams
- - they lose their concentration easily
- - they often make many misspellings (they write what they hear)
- - so-called loud thinking, humming and assenting are typical
- - they often get into discussions
- - Their emotions are revealed by their chaotic speech and repeating



How many types of kinesthetic are there?

- there are two types of kinesthetics: with visual domination and with auditory domination



Each of them has different learning system.

Kinesthetic

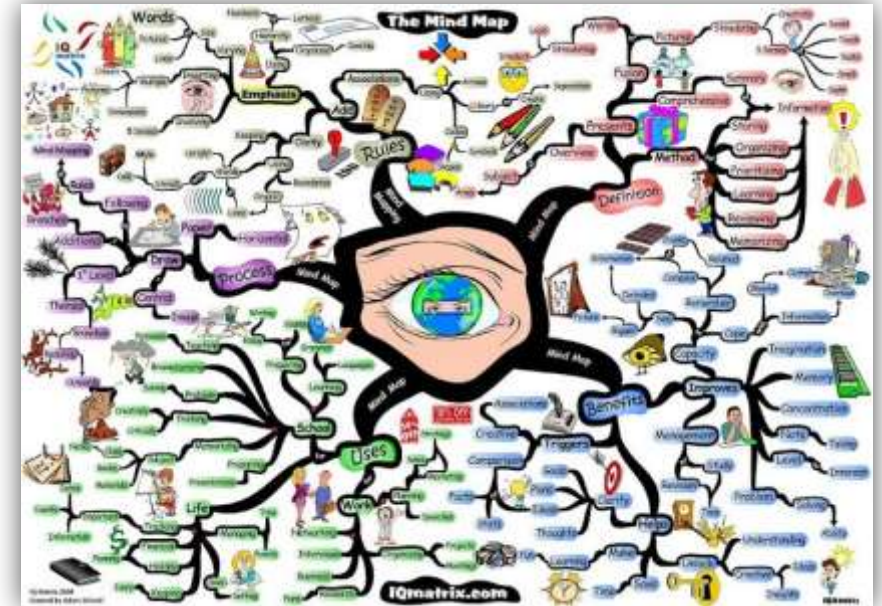
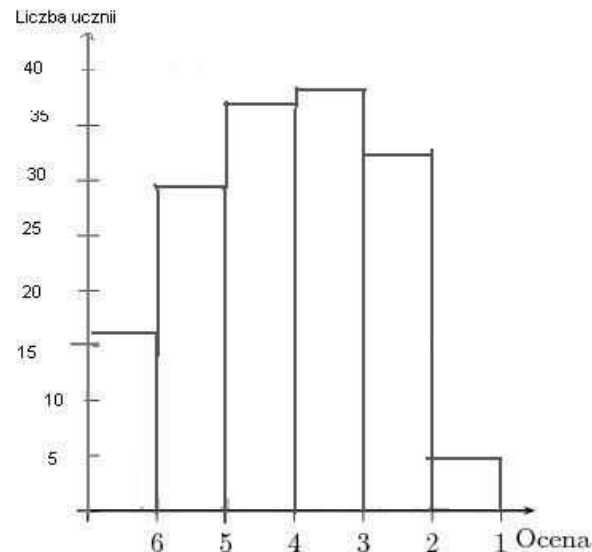


- - moving while reading, often making breaks and short workouts
- - experimenting
- - themed drawing
- - squeezing a little ball in hand while learning. It can be replaced with a small gummy toy or something similar, enjoyable in touch
- - underlining and marking important informations in color
- - learning aloud while moving
- - taking part in games, tournaments and contests



kinesthetic with the dominance of visual-kinesthetic sensory channel

- creating projects, making models
- putting contents on a timeline
- drawing mental maps
- making diagrams, posters



kinesthetic with the dominance of auditory-kinesthetic sensory channel



- revising everything aloud while walking
 - verbal describing accompanied by excessive and theatrical gesticulates, picturing what they are talking about in the same time
- humming, rhythmically dancing
